2009 NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

These races will be governed by the rules, as defined by the current Racing Rules of Sailing ("RRS"). One-design class rules shall apply. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions govern.

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising shall be limited to Class A, unless otherwise directed by class rules or a class's Olympic status.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Classes given starts will be Stars, Ensigns, and any other class of four or more boats that sail consistently (by prior arrangement with the race committee).
- 3.2 Contestants shall register with their respective class fleets, which shall set and collect all fees.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 The first warning signal each day will be made at 0930. The order of starts for the first race of the day is Class I (Stars), Class II (Ensigns), and Class III (any other classes). If the race committee intends to start another race for a class, it will display the Second Substitute (with no sound) and the class flags(s) of the class(es) having another race, while boats are finishing.
- 4.2 The scheduled race committee for each Sunday is indicated below.

- 4.3 Normally there will be one long race for Stars.
- 4.4 Normally there will be two short races for Ensigns, except on days marked "(1)", "(1/2)" or "(3)" above, where:
 - 4.4.1 (1) means one long race only for Ensigns;
 - 4.4.2 (1/2) means one long race for Ensigns, if no races need to be made up, but two short races if a make-up is necessary;
 - 4.4.3 (3) means three short races for Ensigns.
- 4.5 Memorial Day Regatta – May 24 & May 31
- 4.6 Independence Day Regatta – June 28 & July 5
- 4.7 Labor Day Regatta – August 23 and August 30

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at www.centerport-yc.org and from the race committee.

6. COURSES

The courses will be set in Northport and Huntington Bays, and will be described fully in the sailing instructions.

7. PROTESTS

The protest procedure will be described in the sailing instructions. The persons who shall be notified and with whom written protests or requests for redress shall be filed are:
